- **Ms. Costa** reviewed the Budget Adoption process. In 4/22/25 BOE meeting the board adopted the budget that the community will vote on. Some highlights included expansion of ICT program, continued class size reduction which will bring all K-6 classroom sizes down to 20 and below, adding math coaching, looking to start HS class size reduction. For field trips next year, the Board will try to decided earlier if they will have refund available for families. Tax Levy proposed at 1.75%. Need a simple majority to pass the budget, 50% +1 for a pass of the budget for individuals eligible to vote. Discussed plans for covering CSE chair as it was not included in the budget.
- **Mr. Montaterso** discussed state ban on cell phones, smart watches, and non-school sanctioned devices. Schools will be required to have a communication plan for parents to get hold of their children. Climate survey closes on Monday 5/19, results will be reported out to Board and community. Currently about 100 people have responded.
