- Each school organization gave an update on past and upcoming events.
  - Goosehill Primary School (GHPTG):
  - Lloyd Harbor School (LHSPTG): New board members were selected and announced.
  - West Side School (WSSPTG): Grounds position available
  - CSH Junior/Senior High School (CSHPTG): Open positions available
  - Special Education Parent Teacher Organization (SEPTO): Board positions available.

### 6. Special Topics;

- **Mr. Joseph Monastero** gave an update regarding district and specifically Westside.
  - Community has been supportive, providing food for staff working on the building.
  - Staff are cleaning areas thoroughly. The district will need state and fire inspection before allowed to return to the building, including air quality.
  - Since student temporary relocation, staff are meeting daily to check on status in each building and make necessary changes if needed. For example, day-to-day activities such as assemblies, transportation, lunch times. Buildings are conducting fire drills, which is especially important because new students are not used to new buildings.
  - **Music instruments:** Syosset loaned music instruments. About 10 districts are helping with various items. Instruments were not destroyed but they need to be cleaned properly before students can use. The district is working with the various music instrument companies regarding cleaning and possible short term rental process.
  - **The Library and CLL:** will be put into temporary spaces. The district is reviewing temporary solutions.

- **Building construction:** District is working through insurance to cover cost of rebuilding and covering replacement of items.
- **Donations:**
  - If families are interested in donating items, they should reach out to district office to find out what possible needs are.
  - The PTGs are working also and collecting funds to cover PTG items that were lost and any items not be covered through insurance.
  - The WSS PTG created a separate allocation to items that may need to be replaced.
  - WSS PTG will send out Venmo information for families to make donations and in addition to wish list of items that were lost in the PTG closet.
- **Return to WSS building:**
  - Hope to get all grades to return at the same time.
  - Areas that are not accessible will be securely blocked off.
  - Counseling staff is available for students. Parents are asked if they noticed concerns at home to reach out.
  - It will take some time to rebuild the area where Library and CLL were housed, district will work to communicate timing when it is available.
  - WSS Librarian is working on book/material list for short- and long-term needs.
