2024 Meet the Candidates Night – Guidelines The following guidelines for the evening must be adhered to:

- 1. *No* letters or statements by *absent candidates* will be read. Only the candidates may speak.
- 2. CPC board members will act as moderator, time keeper, and question collectors.
- 3. Each Candidate will be allowed *four (4) minutes* to make a *presentation stating his or her qualifications and reasons for running.* When the four minutes are up, the timekeeper will ring a bell to signify that the sentence must be completed.
- 4. All questions will be submitted by email and will be consolidated as necessary in an effort to cover as many topics as possible within the time period. Questions will be asked of <u>all candidates</u>. The moderator will make the final decision regarding all questions.
- 5. Each candidate is given the opportunity to answer each question *in two* (2) *minutes*. When the time is up, the timekeeper will ring a bell indicating the candidate must finish the sentence. No rebuttals are allowed during the question and answer period.
- 6. Each candidate will be allowed *two* (2) *minutes* to make a closing statement after the last question has been answered.
- 7. The program will begin at 7 PM and the last question will be asked no later than 9:30 PM. There will be a 15 minute meet and greet following the summation.
- 8. Presentations will be in alphabetical order by last name.
- 9. Summations will be in reverse order.
- 10.*No literature* may be given out at this meeting by the candidate or by the candidate's supporters.
- 11. The use of cell phones, computers, smart watches, or any other devices will not be permitted.
