- SEPTO hosted "Meet the CSH Professionals" on October 17th where 12 professionals representing all schools were present. These professionals included Special Education, Psychologists, Social Workers, AIS teachers, and service providers such as Speech and OT.
 - This meeting was well attended by our membership. Questions raised by attendees included topics such as:
 - More clarify on district processes such as IST, AIS, and IEP/504 classification
 - Mental health support for children having issues making friends/social anxiety
 - Mentoring
